If property is rented or leased permission to burn must be granted in writing by the property owner.

TEAR OFF KEEP BOTTOM

ALLOWABLE MATERIALS TO BURN

Dry weeds, garden waste, irrigation ditches, trees and shrub trimmings less than one inch in diameter.

BURN PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

1. Burning is permitted only during daylight hours 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and must be out at this time.
2. An adult must constantly attend the fire.
3. Burning of household waste or trash, scrap lumber, or anything other than the allowed materials listed above is NOT PERMITTED.
4. Burning of materials that cause a dense smoke or odor, such as tires or lawn clippings is NOT PERMITTED.
5. The following SAFETY PRECAUTIONS shall be followed: Have water hose, fire extinguisher, or other appropriate source available.
6. Keep a minimum of 50 feet from any structure or butane tank.
7. DO NOT BURN WHEN WIND COULD CAUSE THE FIRE TO GET OUT OF CONTROL.

PENALTIES

Anyone burning without a permit or permission may be issued a citation. The fire will be put out and a complaint will be signed. The individuals may be fined \$300 and will be liable for fighting the fire and/or property damage costs.

RECOMMENDED ALTERNATIVES TO BURNING

Composting involves the decomposition of organic materials, including yard waste. Compost acts as a natural fertilizer enriching the soil. Contact your WASTE COMPANY or CITY for details on scheduling a special pick up.
